### 1. Wrap black tape around straw.

# ib-Sticks

These laughter\_provoking, moving mouth puppets can be made in various forms. They can serve as attention getters and conversation starters at a variety of events as well as for actual performances (great for vaudeville acts and for delivering one liners). The simple version consists of a pair of lips, with a tri-fold "mouth piece" (see pattern Piece A below) glued to top and bottom lips, and operated by your hand, or placed between your teeth. Instructions for the deluxe version with a hand operated rod control are detailed below. You can draw your own lips, cut them out of magazines, or blow up photographs of your friends and family, mount on card stock, and cut out the lips.

### Materials Needed:

## Instructions for Deluxe Version

- A set of lips (upper and lower)

- Heavy Tag board or plasticized cover stock Tools Needed: (for inside of mouth and finger control)

- Scissors

- 14" long wire (ex. piece of coat hanger) - Black tape ( gaff or electricians)

- Needle nose pliers with cutter - Paper punch (1/4 inch)

Scale: 1/4" = 1"

- Glue Stick

Wrap 4" thin piece of tape around wire about 1" from end, spray paint or color
