A chance to see San Diego Art Prize winners' work

The first year of the San Diego Art Prize is drawing to a close and all six of the award-winning artists for 2006/2007, established and emerging, will be on view in a exhibition opening June 30 at downtown's L Street Fine Art at the Omni hotel. This strong group of artists includes Raul Guerrero, Jean Lowe, Ernest Silva, Yvonne Venegas, Iana Quesnell and May-ling Martinez.

They will also have a joint exhibition at the California Center for the Arts Museum opening March 1, 2008.

Already, the three artists who will be receiving the established artist prize for 2007/2008 have been announced: They are conceptualist, photographer and filmmaker Eleanor Antin; sculptor Roman de Salvo; and an artist who works comfortably in many media, Marcos Ramirez (ERRE).

As before, each of these established artists will get to choose an emerging one; then the paired artists will have a concurrent exhibition during the coming year at L Street Fine Art. They have the option of making their picks from a pool of 17 candidates chosen by a committee of art professionals.

The candidates' work can be seen in an exhibition opening downtown Friday in Simayspace at the Art Academy of San Diego. The promisingly varied list includes painters Brad Streeper and Pamela Jaeger, conceptual artists Lael Corbin and Brian Dick, multimedia image-maker Tania Candiani and a sculptor who favors public settings, Alison Wiese.
